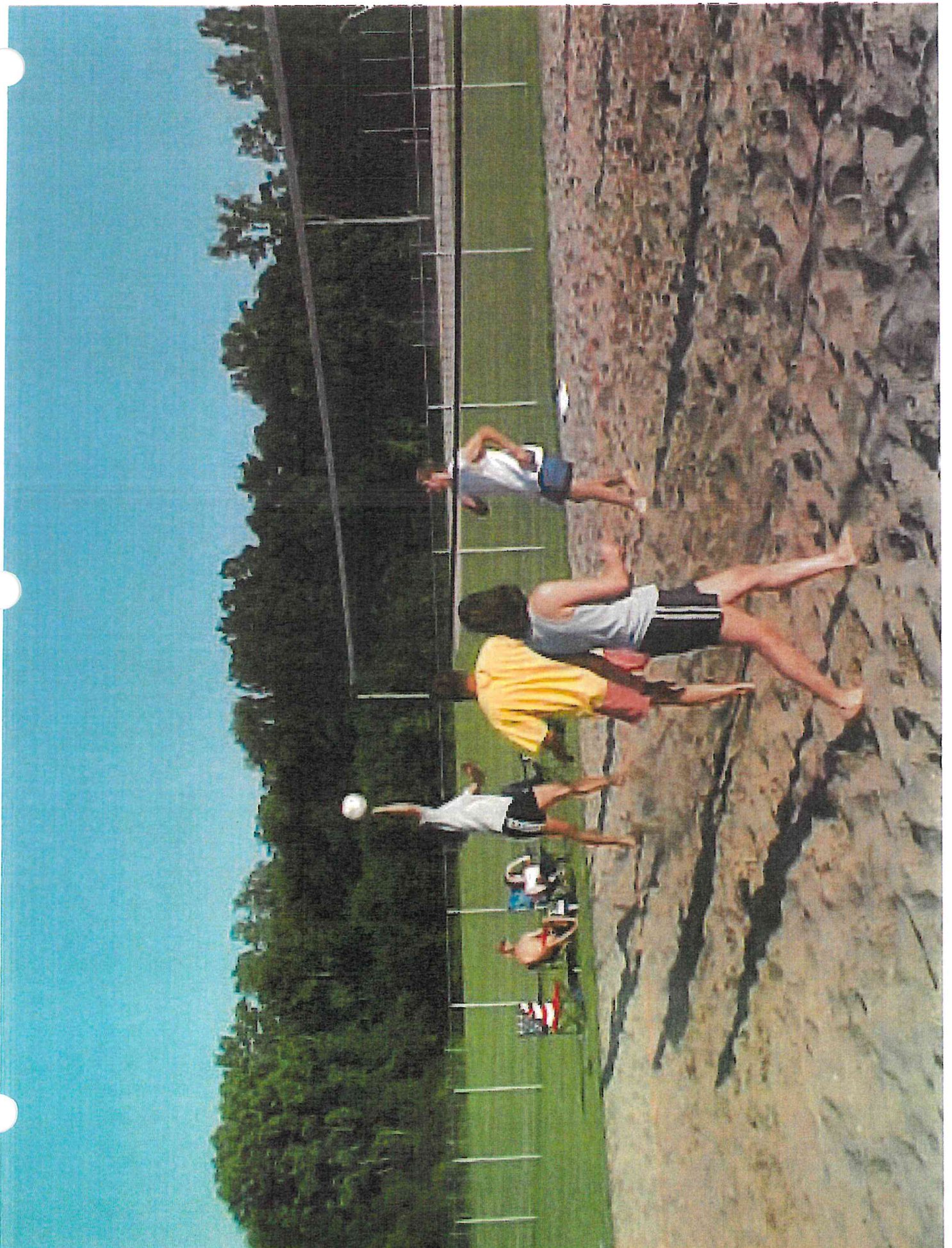


Central Park - pavilion & restroom facility with electricity - capacity 100-125
