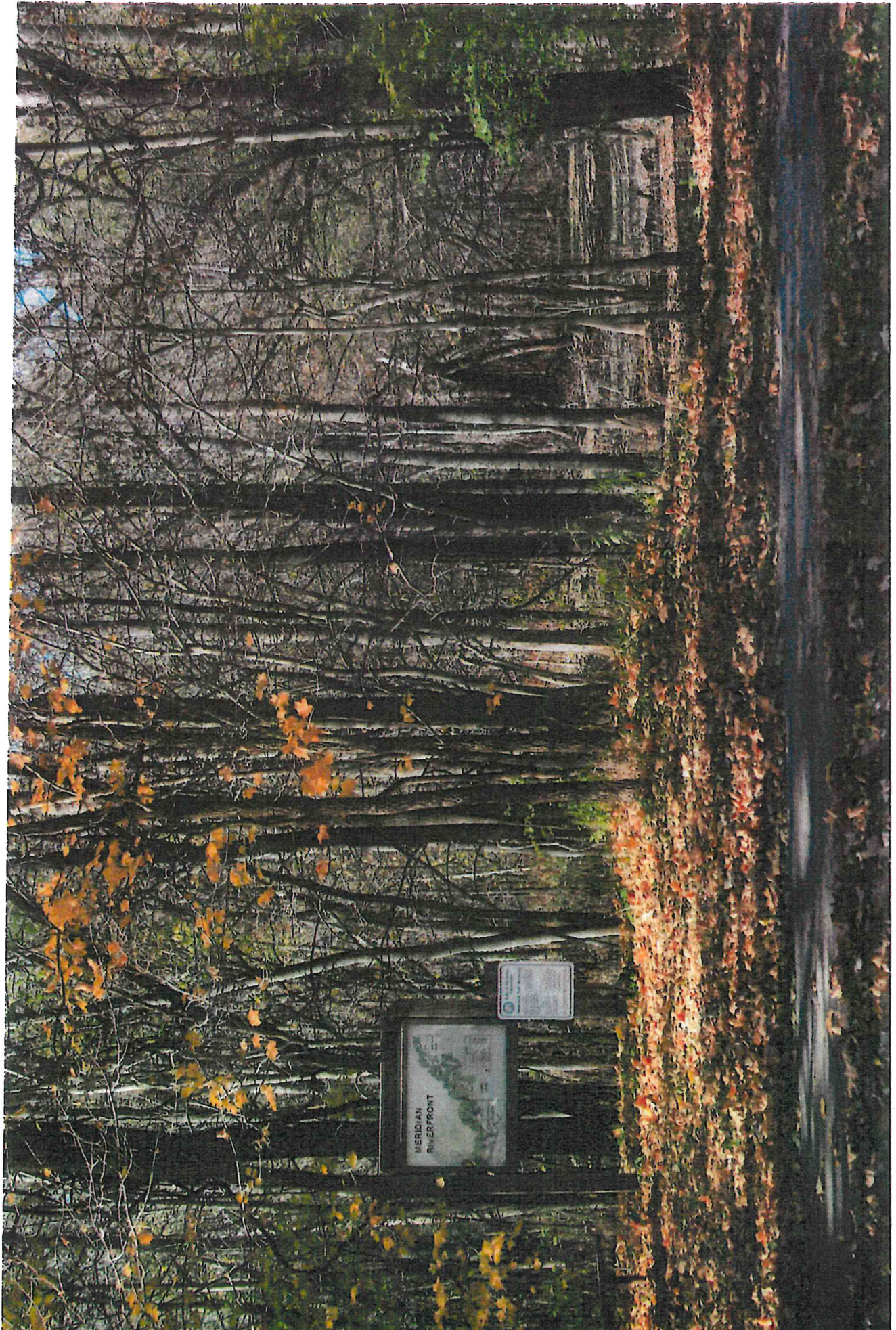

Harris Nature Center and Eastgate Trails

Trail Conditions

Some parts of these trails are located within the floodplain and may be wet, or even impassable during rainy seasons. Please do not ride bikes or horses on the trails at these times.

The distances on the legend refer to the entire trail length. To learn the exact distance of the route you walked, stop into the Harris Nature Center, 3998 Van Atta Road.

The lower Beech Tree Loop is closed because the trail has been washed out by the river.
