POINTS TO REMEMBER:

1. **Please do not park vehicles on the street until the work is complete.**
2. You will have access to your drive at all times, except during the short application period, during which any work crew member can assist you.
3. A given road is typically reopened to traffic in 30 to 60 minutes. Please observe all signs and flagman directions during the work.
4. **Drive SLOWLY (5 mph) if you accidentally enter a freshly treated area. This is to prevent the treatment from getting on your car.**
5. If you do get any of the rejuvenator onto your car, use an auto cleaner to wash off the material.
6. **Pavement must remain dry immediately before and during the treatment process. Please refrain from using lawn sprinklers, washing cars, etc. on the day of treatment.**
7. Rain will delay work until the following day.
8. Sand covering on your roadway will be swept up within two days. Use CAUTION when driving on sand. The sand is applied to absorb the excess materials and reopen the road in a timely manner.
9. **Keep children and pets out of treated areas to avoid tracking into your house.**
10. Material tracked onto drives will weather off in three weeks or less, and will leave no stain.
