## **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE**

### **2023 Construction Project Lake Lansing Road Abbot Road to Hagadorn Road**

A Public Information Meeting is scheduled for **4:00-6:00 pm** on Wednesday, **June 21, 2023** at **the East Lansing Public Library** in the Conference Room located at **950 Abbot Rd, East Lansing, MI 48823**.

The Ingham County Road Department invites the public to attend an open house meeting to discuss the upcoming Lake Lansing Road construction project, which will convert the existing four lane roadway to a three-lane roadway from Abbott Road to Hagadorn Road. The new roadway will have one lane in each direction with a center left turn lane, and paved shoulders. The Lake Lansing intersection with Towar Ave and Birch Row Dr will be realigned and include a new traffic signal.

The contractor will begin construction work on **June 26th**. Lake Lansing Rd, Towar Ave, and Birch Row Dr will be closed to through traffic at the intersection and detoured beginning on **July 10th** with scheduled completion of the intersection work by **August 25th**. Final paving on Lake Lansing Rd between Abbot Rd and Hagadorn Rd will take place after the intersection is reopened and will be done under lane closure. Project completion is scheduled to occur by **September 29th**. Local traffic access will be maintained for residents, businesses, and at Albert A. White Park throughout construction. However, short duration closures may be necessary at times to complete certain construction activities.
