Hello Meridian Township,

I understand there is a meeting this evening at 5:30 to discuss and vote on a assistance package to help offset the high cost of home tree clean up from last weeks storm. I am in favor of this and please read below:

Last weeks storm blew down a large Oak tree that had a trunk diameter of over 4 feet! It fell between my home 4389 Heartwood Rd and my neighbor's home 4383 Heartwood Rd. It was located on my property but did a tremendous amount of damage to 4383 Heartwood Rd. The tree cutting has taken 3 days and they have not finished because they need special heavy equipment to lift and remove the extremely large 4' diameter trunk. Insurance will not pay for removal of tree not

laying on the home, and the cost will be 4 to 5 thousand dollars. Is there any way that we can apply for state assistance to help pay for cleanup? Attached are some pictures of tree damage.
