Judging

Following the entry deadline, community members will be able to vote for their favorite photos for each age group. Photo entries will be on displayed online and in CADL's Haslett and Okemos Branches. Voting will be open May 1-31.

An overall winner will be selected for each Age Group. Along with a winner for each themed category.

Overall winners will receive a gift certificate to Meridian Township Parks & Recreation for use on sports programs, nature center summer camps, pavilion rentals, and special events. Winners will be notified in June and publicly announced at the Celebrate Meridian Festival on Saturday, June 28.
